Resumé of National Committee Work

THE National Committee on Boys and Girls Club Work is a privately supported, voluntary group of public-spirited citizens, incorporated not for profit to assist the Extension Services of the State Agricultural Colleges and the United States Department of Agriculture in furthering the program, membership and influence of the 4-H Clubs. This organization has, since 1921, served as a liaison group to coordinate the interests of public-spirited citizens wishing to further 4-H Club work. Scores of individuals and groups each year help to make the varied services of the Committee possible.

The National Committee has no administrative or supervisory duties in

connection with 4-H Club work, but enjoys the close cooperation of Federal, State and County Extension agents who conduct the work. 4-H Clubs have their national headquarters in the Federal Extension Service, U. S. Department of Agriculture, Washington, D. C., and maintain state headquarters at each of the State Agricultural Colleges.

From the beginning the public was enthusiastic about the idea of a nationwide citizens' committee to further 4-H Clubs. The activities increased and broadened through the years and the work has kept pace with changes in the 4-H Club program. Briefly, the activities of the National Committee are:

1. Solicits and supervises the annual expenditure of approximately \$200,000.00 for the furtherance of 4-H Club work.
2. Publishes National 4-H Club News, a bi-monthly magazine.
3. Assists in planning and conducting the National 4-H Club Congress which attracts approximately 1,400 4-H boys and girls to Chicago each December.
4. Maintains a mail-order supply department for the convenience of 4-H Club leaders. Any profits accruing are transferred to the general fund.
5. Publishes and distributes music, plays and other supplemental material.
6. Assists the Extension Services in publicizing 4-H Club work through the newspapers and magazines.
7. Secures funds for scientific research and publishes results.
8. Assists in securing legislation providing funds for 4-H Club work.

These services to the 4-H Club movement are made possible through the generosity of the public which recog-

nizes the significance of 4-H Club work in the field of informal education and in building character and citizenship.

HOW TO ORDER

1. Order early. Give date pins are needed — not a previous date. Such orders are given preference.
2. Select the design specified in your state pin policy. If you haven't this information contact your county extension agent or write your state club office.
3. All orders for official pins **MUST BE APPROVED** by your STATE CLUB LEADER. In some states County Extension Agents can approve orders. Orders will be held by us until they are approved. Avoid this delay in shipment.
4. Note carefully the description of each design. If pins are out of stock, substitutions will be made on "RUSH" orders only, providing the state pin policy offers a choice of designs.
